We are excited and happy to announce that our first "Peaceful Lives: Conflict Resolution within Muslim families' Training Program, co-organized with Odisee University College - Higher Institute for Family Studies in Brussels, was a success.

Over 30 participants from different backgrounds took part in the training during the past months and gained highly valuable knowledge on conflict resolution, Islamic perspectives on conflicts and mediation, having a unique chance to develop their conflict resolution skills for working with Muslim families in Belgium.

On Saturday June 4th we celebrated the graduation of the first participants to this ground-breaking bilingual French and Dutch training program.
